

AlzheimerChain - report of activities H1 / 2020

Company AlzheimerChain Foundation s.r.o. was founded at the end of 2019 and registered in the Czech Commercial Register in January 2020. AlzheimerChain Foundation began its official activities in the same month. All information about the project can be found on the website: www.alzheimerchain.com.

Our company has published **two press releases**, which can also be found on the website or in the appendix of this report.

During Q1 2020, we began our first negotiations with potential investors. It is primarily a cooperation with the external sales network of **FABA CAPITAL LTD**, which will be responsible for the investment strategy.

We also focused on the internal investment and sales activities in the same time. We started to present our project in the form of a **Zoom video presentation** to small investors and we also decided to strengthen the internal sales channel. We are newly opening the position of sales director, who will be responsible for the company's sales and investment strategy.
